- RANK AND POSITION:** Assistant/Associate Professor of Business Administration
- EFFECTIVE DATE:** January 1, 2009 or Until Filled
- SALARY:** Negotiable
- AREAS OF SPECIALIZATION:** Logistics, Supply Chain Management or closely related field
- QUALIFICATIONS:** Applicants for this tenure-track position should possess an earned Doctorate degree in Logistics Management or a closely related field, including at least eighteen semester hours of graduate level coursework in Logistics and/or Supply Chain Management from an accredited university. The ideal candidate would also have collegiate teaching experience, relevant industry experience and logistics certification(s). Evidence of scholarly activities, i.e., in-field, published research, grant writing or other external funding efforts, is required. Doctorate degree candidates (ABD) will be considered.
- MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES:** The individual filling this position will teach undergraduate and graduate courses in Business and/or Logistics Management, advise students, serve on departmental and university committees, participate in university functions and perform other duties as assigned.
- THE INSTITUTION:** Albany State University is fully accredited by the SACS and a unit of the University System of Georgia. The College of Business currently has twenty (20) full-time faculty members, it is fully accredited by the ACBSP and pursuing accreditation by the AACSB-International. The College of Business offers the Bachelor of Science degrees in Accounting, Business Information Systems, Business Management, Management (Healthcare) and Marketing. A recently-approved B.S. in Supply Chain and Logistics Management will begin in Spring, 2009. Also offered is a minor in International Business and the Master of Business Administration degree.
