- RANK AND POSITION:** Assistant/Associate Professor of Criminal Justice
- EFFECTIVE DATE:** January 1, 2009 or Until Filled
- SALARY:** Negotiable
- AREAS OF SPECIALIZATION:** Criminal Justice
- QUALIFICATIONS:** A Ph.D. or Doctorate terminal degree in Criminal Justice, Criminology or closely related field with research skills is required. A doctorate degree along with a Juris Doctorate (JD) will be a plus. Applicants having only a JD degree will not suffice. We are particularly interested in candidates with Research and statistical background who can teach both graduate and undergraduate Research methods and Statistics classes and ability to use of S.P.S.S. or other software programs on personal computers are a plus. Strong knowledge and experience in online teaching will also be appealing and will receive stronger consideration. Candidates must have a commitment to community service, research and quality teaching. Computer competence is highly desirable. Some experience in Forensic Science will also be a plus. Evidence of scholarly professional activities, i.e., in-field research publication, grant writing and other external funding opportunity, is required. Doctorate degree candidates (ABD) will be considered.
- MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES:** The successful applicant will be expected to teach graduate and undergraduate classes and assist students on both levels. Other duties will include graduate student thesis supervision, conducting basic or applied research, assistance to faculty and staff in applications of computer technology and data analysis, advisement, committee work, and other responsibilities as assigned. Knowledge and experience in grantsmanship are needed.
- THE INSTITUTION:** Albany State University is a fully accredited unit of the University System of Georgia. The Department of Criminal Justice is housed within the Criminal Justice Institute and has eight faculty members. The Department of Criminal Justice offers Bachelor of Science degrees in Criminal Justice and Forensic Science; and a Masters of Science degree in Criminal Justice.
