- RANK AND POSITION:** Assistant/Associate Professor of Chemistry
- EFFECTIVE DATE:** August 03, 2009
- SALARY:** Commensurate with training and experience
- AREA(S) OF SPECIALIZATION:** Organic Chemistry
- QUALIFICATIONS:** Applicants for the position should have a Doctorate degree in Chemistry. Training in advanced chemistry disciplines is desirable. Evidence of scholarly, professional activities, i.e. grant writing and other external funding opportunity, publishing and research required.
- MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES:** The individual filling the position will teach undergraduate and graduate courses in Chemistry with an average teaching load of twelve hours per semester, advise students, serve on departmental and university committees, participate in university functions and perform other duties as assigned. The individual will also be expected to engage in academic research and sponsored activities.
