

ANNOUNCEMENT OF POSITION

RANK AND POSITION: Assistant/Associate Professor of Educational Leadership

EFFECTIVE DATE: January, 2009

SALARY: Negotiable

QUALIFICATIONS: Doctorate degree in Educational Leadership required; collegiate teaching experience preferred. Training or experience in school administration, finance, management and educational foundations is also desirable. Doctorate degree candidates (ABD) will be considered.

MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES: The individual filling the position will teach graduate courses in Educational Leadership with an average teaching load of twelve (12) hours per semester, advise students, serve on departmental and university committees, participate in university functions, engage in scholarly activities and perform other duties as assigned. Teaching assignments may include undergraduate Foundation Courses.

THE INSTITUTION: Albany State University is a fully accredited unit of the University System of Georgia. The College of Education currently has thirty-five (35) faculty members. The College of Education offers Bachelor's, Master's, and Specialist's degrees.

Faculty members receive all benefits provided by the University System of Georgia, including hospital and major medical insurance, group life insurance and participation in the Georgia Teachers' Retirement System, Optional Retirement Plan and Social Security.
