

## **ANNOUNCEMENT OF POSITION**

- POSITION:** Assistant/Associate Professor of Music
- EFFECTIVE DATE:** August 1, 2009
- RANK AND SALARY:** Negotiable (Depending upon Qualifications)
- AREA(S) OF SPECIALIZATION:** Music with specialty in accompanying, vocal coaching and piano pedagogy.
- MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES:** Instructor in this position will teach undergraduate and graduate courses in music, as well as other major courses and /or applied lessons commensurate with background and experience. Also, faculty member will contribute to the continuous development and improvement of the music and music education curriculums. Creative endeavors, i.e. recitals, participation in performance ensembles, or other scholarly activities are strongly encouraged.
- QUALIFICATIONS:** Applicants for the position should have a Doctorate degree in Music or area academic or performance specialty. Applicants who are currently, or are nearing ABD status will be considered. Applicants with backgrounds in applied piano as a primary or secondary emphasis will be given priority consideration. Knowledge of computers and computer technology is highly desirable.
- THE INSTITUTION:** Albany State University is a fully accredited unit of the University System of Georgia. Music is one of the three divisions (Art, Music, and Speech and Theater) within the Department of Fine Arts. There are currently fourteen full-time faculty members in the department, seven of which are music faculty. The Department currently offers the Bachelor of Arts and the Bachelor Music Education degrees.
- Faculty members receive all benefits provided by the University System, including hospital and major medical insurance, group life insurance and participation in the Georgia Teachers Retirement System, Optional Retirement Plan and Social Security.
- APPLICATION PROCEDURE:** Priority consideration will be given to applications received on or before May 1, 2009. Applicant screening process will begin immediately, and continue until the position is filled. Current federal law requires identification and eligibility verification prior to employment. Only U.S. citizens and aliens authorized to work in the United States may be employed.
