- RANK AND POSITION:** Assistant Professor of English
- EFFECTIVE DATE:** August 2009
- SALARY:** Negotiable
- QUALIFICATIONS:** Candidates must have a Doctorate in English Literature (preference for Early British Literature) or Rhetoric and Composition.
- MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES:** The individual filling the position will have a teaching load of twelve hours per semester in a range of undergraduate courses and select graduate courses in English with consideration for the successful candidate's area of concentration. In addition, the successful candidate will serve on department and university committees, participate in university functions, and perform other duties as assigned.
- THE INSTITUTION:** Albany State University is a fully accredited unit of the University System of Georgia. The Department of English, Modern Languages and Mass Communication currently has twenty-four full-time faculty members. The Department offers the B.A. degree in English, Spanish and Mass Communication and graduate courses for the M.Ed. in English Education.
