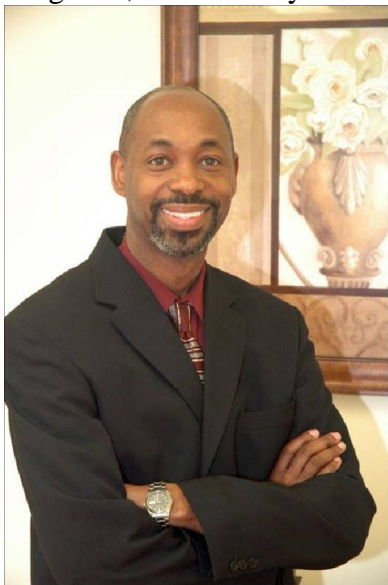

## **Wrensford elected to Council on Undergraduate Research**

Dr. Granville Wrensford, associate vice president for Research and Sponsored Programs, was recently elected to a three-year term as a councilor in the At-Large Division on the Council on Undergraduate Research (CUR).
