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ABOUT THE INSTITUTION

Established in 1903, Albany State University is a Historically Black College and University (HBCU) located in Albany, GA. In 2016, Albany State University consolidated with Darton State College, an access institution, into the new Albany State University. The institution builds upon the HBCU mission to serve an increasingly diverse student population and will continue to serve the access mission, offering workforce related degrees. With an enrollment of 6,324 (fall 2021), Albany State University is the largest Historically Black College in Georgia.

All through its history, Albany State University has been a catalyst for change in the Southwest Georgia region. The University is dedicated to educating students to become outstanding contributors to society.

The University offers certificates, transfer associate's degrees, career associate's, bachelor's, master's, and specialist degrees through the three colleges: College of Arts and Sciences, College of Professional Studies, and Darton College of Health Professions. The University emphasizes the liberal arts as the foundation for all learning by exposing students to humanities, fine arts, social sciences, and natural sciences. Global learning is fostered through a broadbased curriculum, diverse university activities, and expanding use of technology.

Total Economic Impact Locally

The economic impact of the university on an eightcounty region is calculated to be more than \$244 million, according to a study released in 2019 by the University System of Georgia.

Tuition and Fees for Fiscal Year 2021 – 2022

Tuition and fees for an undergraduate associate fulltime student taking at least 15 hours who is a resident of the state of Georgia are \$4,720. Out-of-state tuition and fees for an undergraduate associate full-time student taking at least 15 hours are \$12,660. Tuition and fees for an undergraduate bachelor full-time student taking at least 15 hours who is a resident of the state of Georgia are \$6,950. Tuition and fees for an undergraduate bachelor full-time student taking at least 15 hours who is not a resident of the state of Georgia are \$20,352. Tuition and fees for a graduate full-time student taking at least 9 hours who is a resident of the state of Georgia are \$5,308. Out-ofstate tuition and fees for a graduate full-time student taking at least 9 hours are \$15,586.



Fall 2017 - Fall 2021, Enrollment by Class






Fall 2017 - Fall 2021, Enrollment by Registration Status

Fall 2017 - Fall 2021, Enrollment by Gender









Fall Retention Rates of First-Time, Full-Time Freshmen





Retention Rates of First-Time, Full-Time Freshmen Bachelor's Degree Seeking Students


Fall One-Year Retention Rates of First-Time, Full-Time Freshmen Bachelor's Degree Seeking Students

Retention Rates for First-Time, Full-Time Bachelor's Degree Seeking Students by Gender



Retention Rates of First-Time, Full-Time Freshmen Associate Degree Seeking Students









Fiscal Year 2021 Degrees Awarded by College and Gender



FY 2021 Degree Awarded by College and Race/Ethnicity




FY 2021 Degrees Awarded by College


Graduation Rates of Bachelor's Degree Seeking First-time, Full-time Freshmen




Graduation Rates of Associate's Degree Seeking First-Time, Full-Time Freshmen


Three-Year Graduation Rate of Associate's Degree Seeking First-Time Full-Time Freshmen





Fall 2019-2021, Employee by Employment Status



Fall 2019-2021, Employee by Gender and Race/Ethnicity







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
