Mental Measurements Yearbook contains full-text information on commercially-available, standardized English-language tests covering educational skills, personality, vocational aptitude, psychology, and related areas. Information given on instruments includes test name and classification, author (s), publisher, publication date, price, time requirements, existence of validity and reliability data, score descriptions, levels, and intended populations.

JSTOR is an Arts & Sciences Collection that covers language and literature journals on Dickinson, Wright, African American Studies et. al.

MasterFILE Premier is a general database created for a public library audience. It provides abstracts and indexing for over 2,690 as well as full text for over 1,800 journals and general magazines covering nearly all subjects including general reference, business, consumer health, general science, and multicultural periodicals.

Mental Measurements Yearbook contains full-text information on commercially-available, standardized English-language tests covering educational skills, personality, vocational aptitude, psychology, and related areas. Information given on instruments includes test name and classification, author (s), publisher, publication date, price, time requirements, existence of validity and reliability data, score descriptions, levels, and intended populations.

Physical Education Index provides citations and abstracts on a wide variety of content, ranging from physical education curricula, to sports medicine, to dance. Other coverage includes sport law, kinesiology, motor learning, recreation, standardized fitness tests, sports equipment, business and marketing, coaching and training, health education, physical therapy, and sport sociology/psychology.

Primary Search is designed for students at the elementary-grade level. 55 full-text publications as well as 120 general publications for professionals working with students on the primary/elementary level are included. 300 full text pamphlets are also included.

The Professional Development Collection is a specialized Collection of journal articles and pamphlets especially for professional educators that includes abstract and index coverage for 800 professional development titles and searchable full text for over 500 journals covering the most current topics in the field of education.

Research Library 1986- Subject categories in this database include Law and Criminology, Medicine, Medicine and Health Sciences, Biology, Books and Book Reviews, Chemistry and Physics, General and Multi-Subject, News, Nursing and Allied Health, Sociology, Social Sciences, and many others.

SocINDEX with Full Text features more than 1,300,000 records with subject headings from a 15,600 term sociology-specific thesaurus designed by expert lexicographers. This database contains abstracts for more than 620 "core" coverage journals dating back to 1895.
