Academic Search Premier (ASP) 1975—This scholarly collection offers information in nearly every area of academic study including Medical sciences, computer sciences, engineering, physics, chemistry, language and linguistics, arts & literature, ethnic studies, and many more. ASP provides full text for nearly 4,650 serials, including full text for more than 3600 peer reviewed titles as far back as 1975.

Alt Health Watch—Focuses on multiple perspectives of complementary, holistic, and integrated approaches to health care and wellness. Full-text content comes from more than 160 international peer-reviewed and professional journals, magazines, reports, proceedings, and association and consumer newsletters, plus hundreds of pamphlets, booklets, special reports, original research, and book excerpts.

CINHL Plus with Full Text—provides abstracts and indexing as well as full text for hundreds of journals, plus legal cases, clinical innovations, critical paths, drug records, research instruments and clinical trials with indexing back to 1937. It contains English-language nursing journals and publications from the National League for Nursing and the American Nurses' Association. The database covers nursing, biomedicine, health sciences librarianship, alternative/complementary medicine, consumer health and 17 allied health disciplines. In addition, this database offers access to health care books, nursing dissertations, selected conference proceedings, standards of practice, educational software, audiovisuals and book chapters, as well as Evidence-Based Care Sheets.

Clinical Pharmacology—Contains current, concise and clinically-relevant drug monographs for all U.S. prescription drugs, hard-to-find herbal and nutritional supplements, over-the-

counter products and new and investigational drugs. Drugs may be searched by their generic or brand names.

Health Source: Nursing/ Academic Edition—provides nearly 520 scholarly full-text journals focusing on nursing, allied health fields, and many medical disciplines as well as abstracts and indexing for over 550 journals. Also included are the *USP Pharmacopoeia DI: Volume II Advice for the Lay Patient* and *Stedman's Medical Dictionary*

The Merck Manual—For over 100 years have provided detailed information on virtually all disorders and complete with discussion of symptoms and current therapy. The publisher provides free access to three Merck Manuals: The Merck Manual of Diagnosis and Therapy, 17th Centennial Edition—published 1999; The Home Edition providing medical information in everyday language; and The Merck Manual of Geriatrics, published 2000.

NLM Gateway(National Library of Medicine)—The National Library of Medicine (NLM), on the campus of the National Institutes of Health in Bethesda, Maryland, is the world's largest medical library. The Library collects materials and provides Information and research services in all areas of biomedicine and health care.

Pre-CINAHL: Nursing and Allied Health—A companion database to CINAHL, **Pre-CINAHL** is intended to provide current awareness of new journal articles and includes a rotating file of limited bibliographic information (no subject searching), which are available to researchers only for the time when these articles are being assigned additional indexing. This enables users to gain access to article citations that otherwise would not be available. Once the bibliographic records are complete, they are added to the CINAHL database and removed from Pre-CINAHL.

Research Library 1986—Subject categories in this database include Law and Criminology, Medicine, Medicine and Health Sciences, Biology, Books and Book Reviews, Chemistry and Physics, General and Multi-Subject, News, Nursing and Allied Health, Sociology, Social Sciences, and many others.

Scopus (Trail Access)—an abstracts database of 27 million records covering articles from 14,000 peer-reviewed titles from more than 4,000 international publishers with access to abstracts in the scientific, medical, technical and social science arena. It has significant coverage of scientific, technical, medical and social sciences literature, plus 14,000 peer-reviewed titles from over 4,000 international publishers including 531 Open Access journals 60% of titles are from countries other than the US. Abstracts go back to 1966; References go back to 1996; 81% of content is indexed with controlled vocabularies and 100% coverage of Medline, including unique Medline journals.
