Electronic Databases

Academic Search Premier (ASP) 1975—ASP scholarly Collection offers information in nearly every area of academic study including Medical sciences, computer sciences, engineering, physics, chemistry, language and linguistics, arts & literature, ethnic studies, and many more. ASP provides full text for nearly 4,650 serials, including full text for more than 3600 peer reviewed titles as far back as 1975.

Applied Social Sciences Index and Abstracts (ASSIA)—is an indexing and abstracting tool covering health, social services, psychology, sociology, economics, politics, race relations and education. Updated monthly, ASSIA provides a comprehensive source of social science and health information for the practical and academic professional.

CINAHL Plus with Full Text — provides abstracts and indexing as well as full text for hundreds of journals, plus legal cases, clinical innovations, critical paths, drug records, research instruments and clinical trials with indexing back to 1937.

CSA Illumina— link allows users to search simultaneously all CSA databases available to their library from a single point of access. Results of a search are integrated, but the name of the database from which articles are retrieved is listed. Duplicate records with not be eliminated. Users can quickly select topical database sets or individual databases to search from this interface.

ERIC (Education Resources Information Center), —ERIC (Educational Resources Information Center) Online provides over 800,000 references to thousands of educational topics. It includes journal articles, books, theses, curricula, conference papers, and standards and guidelines. Coverage is from 1966 to the present.

MEDLINE with Full Text (at EBSCOhost) —combines the National Library of Medicine's bibliographic database with links to the complete text of articles from leading medical journals. The database offers information related to the fields of medicine, nursing, dentistry, veterinary medicine, the health care system, and preclinical sciences.

Mental Measurements Yearbook —contains full-text information on commercially-available, standardized English-language tests covering educational skills, personality, vocational aptitude, psychology, and related areas. Information given on instruments includes test name and classification, author (s), publisher, publication date, price, time requirements, existence of validity and reliability data, score descriptions, levels, and intended populations. Published reviews of the tests are referenced. MMY provides coverage from Volume 9 to the present.

The Merck Manuals—have been standard medical reference sources for over 100 years providing detailed information on virtually all disorders, complete with discussion of symptoms and current therapy.

PsycARTICLES —covers general psychology and specialized basic, applied, clinical, and theoretical research in psychology. Over 25,000 full-text articles are available from 42 journals published by American Psychological Association, Canadian Psychological Association, and Hogrefe & Huber.

PsycINFO —contains citations and summaries of journal articles, book chapters, books, and technical reports, as well as citations to dissertations, in the field of psychology and psychological aspects of related disciplines

Research Library 1986—Subject categories in this database include Law and Criminology, Medicine, Medicine and Health Sciences, Biology, Books and Book Reviews, Chemistry and Physics, General and Multi-Subject, News, Nursing and Allied Health, Sociology, Social Sciences, and many others.

SocIndex with Full-text 1985—Features more than 1,300,000 records with subject headings from a 15,600 term sociology-specific Thesaurus. This database also contains abstracts for more than 620 "core" coverage journals dating back to 1895. SocIndex with Full Text offers coverage from all sub-disciplines of sociology, including criminology, criminal justice, cultural sociology, demography, economic development, ethnic & racial studies, rural sociology, social psychology, social structure, social work, sociological theory, sociology of education, substance abuse, urban studies, violence, welfare, and many others.

The Sociological Collection —is a database with more than 475 full-text titles. It provides information on all areas of sociology, including social behavior, human tendencies, interaction, relationships, community development, culture and social structure.

WorldCat—37 million bibliographic records to books, journals, dissertations, videos, etc. owned by libraries all over the US and in other countries.
