Failing to file on time, however, may prevent you from graduating even if your degree requirements have been completed

- Deadline to remove "I" and "IP" grades before automatic "F" for potential graduates

GRADUATION AT A GLANCE

The Spring Semester Graduation exercises will be held at the James H. Gray Civic Center on Saturday, May 2, 2009 at 9:50 a.m.

Line up begins at 9:00 a.m. No student will be allowed in the line of march after the procession has begun. **Please be on time.**

All students are required to be present to receive their diploma. If it is absolutely necessary that the degree be conferred in absentia, the student should write a letter to the Vice President for Academic Affairs requesting permission to graduate in absentia giving a valid reason why he/she cannot participate. If approval is granted, the diploma will be mailed provided the student has taken care of all obligations, including the exit interview required of all students who have received federal loans and the payment of the graduation fee. A diploma that is to be mailed "certified" to the address on the Application for Graduation/Degree Audit will cost an additional \$7.00 in addition to the graduation fee.

The full amount of the graduation fee is required.

OUTSTANDING REQUIREMENTS

All potential graduates are required to take an exit examination required by their academic department. Scores for any required examination must be on file in the Registrar's Office by February 26, 2009.

All requirements for graduation must be completed by February 26, 2009, except current course work at Albany State University.

Any student with course work that is not received by the deadline date will not be eligible for this graduation.

EXIT INTERVIEWS-FINANCIAL AID

Potential graduates who have not received any financial aid should report to Financial Operations Office and pay the required graduation fee by the deadline date. Prior to graduating, borrowers are required to complete an exit counseling session. All students who received federal loans (Direct Student Loans-Subsidized and Unsubsidized Stafford Loans) are required to complete an on line exit counseling session. This on line exit counseling session will take about 30-40 minutes to complete. A representative from the Financial Office will contact you if you need to visit their office to for an exit interview. COMMENCEMENT APPAREL

Commencement is a very special ceremony. Graduates and family members will be capturing the occasion through snapshots and videotapes. Therefore, it is important that everything is properly coordinated and displayed, including the regalia. Here are some tips for a picture perfect commencement.

Caps should be worn straight on the head with the front point in the center of the forehead. The Bachelor's tassel should be worn on the right side and shifted to the left side at the designated time. Dark shoes, dark colored hose and dark clothing should be worn. No flowers or decorative jewels should be worn. Honor cords (for eligible students) must be cleared through the Registrar's Office before paying the Cashier. Other instructions will be given during the rehearsal.

RECEIPT OF DEGREE

During the commencement ceremony you will receive a diploma cover. The diploma will be issued to you immediately following the ceremony. If the diploma is held, there will be a letter of explanation inside the cover. Please adhere to all deadlines.

NOTE: We will maintain diplomas for only 30 days from each commencement date for students with financial obligations. A request submitted for a name change after the graduation/degree audit will not be changed prior to commencement, and there will be a charge to order another diploma (\$30.00 for the bachelor's and \$40.00 for the specialist and master's degree).

GENERAL INFORMATION

Check your package for a gown, hood, cap, tassel and numeral. Make sure gown and cap fits before leaving the distribution site. There is no guarantee that a diploma will be available by Commencement for those students receiving late departmental clearance for graduation and a late fee may be required. Thank you for adhering to all deadlines.
