

The Pierian Journal Submission Guidelines

General Information

The Pierian accepts original work that has not been published previously.

Submissions made simultaneously are accepted. In the event your work is accepted elsewhere, you must inform us as soon as possible by emailing the editors at ThePierian@asurams.edu.

The Pierian claims first serial rights. All rights revert to the author/artist upon publication.

A 50-word maximum biographical note, written in the third person, must be included with submissions. There is a space in the online submission form for your bio.

Each submission window allows for the inclusion of up to three individual works in one submission. Any combination of written works and/or visual arts may be included.

Response time is 2-4 months after the submission window closes on March 1.

Literature Submissions

- Short fiction up to 2500 words; Nonfiction up to 2000 words.
- Literature submissions must be in .docx or .pdf format. Microsoft Word submissions are preferred.
- Filename must be in the following format:
FirstName-LastName--Title.docx
Example: George-Williams–The-Gateways.docx

Visual Arts Submissions

- We encourage submissions of any visual art that can be submitted in a single 2D format. Drawing, painting, collage, mixed media, photography, graphic design, sculpture, ceramics, performance art, and video still are just a few examples.
- Visual Art Submissions must be in .jpg format, 3300 pixels on the long side (11 inches at 300 dpi on the long side), sRGB color profile. If published the submitted image will not be edited in any form, but may be reduced in size to fit the publication.
- Filename must be in the following format:
FirstName-LastName--Artwork-Title.jpg
Example: Jasmine-Smith–Ghost-Among-Us.jpg
