2013-2014 Stafford Loan Application

Processing Steps:

- Once your completed application is received, your information will be entered into our Banner System and forwarded to your advisor. Please allow 14 days for the process to be completed.
- You will be notified by email of your eligibility for the semester.
- If you do not receive any correspondence within 14 days, please email your advisor at <u>ifinaid@asurams.edu</u>. Please use Stafford Loan Application Inquiry as the subject and be sure to include your Name, and RamID.

General Information:

- The deadline for submitting your application for processing prior to registration is April 15th.
- The 2013-2014 FAFSA is required for Federal Pell Grant, Federal College Work-study and Federal Stafford Loans.

Loan Information:

- The Direct Subsidized Loan and Direct Unsubsidized Loan are made through the William D. Ford Federal Direct Loan Program, which is administered by the U.S. Department of Education.
- You are allowed to make adjustments to your loan award. If you make changes to your award amounts,
 please be aware that you may have additional out of pocket cost for those semester(s) with reduced or no
 loan awards.
- Stafford Loan Limits are annual and the maximum amounts are based on earned hours.

Master Promissory Note (required):

- A Master Promissory Note (MPN) must be completed in order for the Stafford loan funds to be disbursed to the student's account. The Master Promissory Note is valid for up to 10 years. If you are required to complete an MPN, you will be notified by email (ASU email address or the email address listed on the FAFSA) or by mail.

 to complete an electronic MPN. You will be required to have a FAFSA Pin.
 If you need to request a pin or retrieve your pin, please go to the Department of Education's PIN

 - Select "Subsidized/Unsubsidized"

Entrance Counseling (required):

• Entrance Counseling is required for first-time borrowers and can be completed online at https://studentloans.gov.

Disbursement Information:

- Direct Loans (Subsidized, Unsubsidized, and Parent PLUS) will be disbursed to the student's account in two equal installments.
- The funds will be disbursed to the student's account 7 to 10 days after the close of registration.
