If you would like to attend an Early Alert and Progress Report Training Session, please sign up below. All new faculty and instructors are strongly encouraged to attend. The monitoring of your Progress Report submission confirms that the student is getting the appropriate interventions to ensure success in your course and will help you track this process. Our Progress Reporting system is an intentional approach to outreach and support of undergraduate students who are struggling academically early enough in the semester to help them find the resources they need to be successful at ASU.

Ahead of the training sessions, all faculty are encouraged to view the training resources located in GaView within the Training Resources folder.

Please note that if a progress report notification is submitted for a student because of attendance, and the student has credit hours greater than 60, it will be the role of their Faculty Advisor to make direct contact with the student to recommend the best course of action. This means, Faculty Advisors must be proactive and contacting students if they receive a progress report alert.
