

O.C.G.A. § 16-11-127.1

O.C.G.A. § 16-11-127.1 : CARRYING WEAPONS WITHIN SCHOOL SAFETY ZONES, AT SCHOOL FUNCTIONS, OR ON A BUS OR OTHER TRANSPORTATION FURNISHED BY A SCHOOL

- (A) AS USED IN THIS CODE SECTION, THE TERM:
- (1) "SCHOOL FUNCTION" MEANS A SCHOOL FUNCTION OR RELATED
 ACTIVITY THAT OCCURS OUTSIDE OF A SCHOOL SAFETY ZONE AND
 IS FOR A PUBLIC OR PRIVATE ELEMENTARY OR SECONDARY
 SCHOOL.
- (2) "SCHOOL SAFETY ZONE" MEANS IN OR ON ANY REAL PROPERTY
 OR BUILDING OWNED BY OR LEASED TO:
- (A) ANY PUBLIC OR PRIVATE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL,

 SECONDARY SCHOOL, OR LOCAL BOARD OF EDUCATION AND USED FOR

 ELEMENTARY OR SECONDARY EDUCATION; AND
- (B) ANY PUBLIC OR PRIVATE TECHNICAL SCHOOL,

 VOCATIONAL SCHOOL, COLLEGE, UNIVERSITY, OR OTHER INSTITUTION OF

 POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION.
- (3) "WEAPON" MEANS AND INCLUDES ANY PISTOL, REVOLVER, OR ANY WEAPON DESIGNED OR INTENDED TO PROPEL A MISSILE OF ANY KIND, OR ANY DIRK, BOWIE KNIFE, SWI TCHBLADE KNIFE, BALLISTIC KNIFE, ANY OTHER KNIFE HAVING A BLADE OF TWO OR MORE INCHES, STRAIGHT-EDGE RAZOR, RAZOR BLADE, SPRING STICK, KNUCLES, WHETHER MADE FROM METAL, THERMO-PLASTICK, WOOD, OR OTHER SIMILAR MATERIAL, BLACKJACK ANY BAT, CLUB.
- (B) (1) IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON TO CARRY TO OR TO POSSESS OR HAVE UNDER SUCH PERSON'S CONTROL WHILE WITHIN A SCHOOL SAFETY ZONE OR AT A SCHOOL FUNCTION, OR ON A BUS OR OTHER TRANSPORTATION FURNISHED BY A SCHOOL ANY WEAPON OR EXPOSIVE

COMPOUND, OTHER THAN FIREWORKS THE POSSESSION OF WHICH IS REGULATED BY CHAPTER 10 OF TITLE 25.

(2) ANY LICENSE HOLDER WHO VIOLATES THIS
SUBSECTION SHALL BE GUILTY OR A MISDEMEANOR. ANY
PERSON WHO IS NOT A LICENSE HOLDER WHO VIOLATES
THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE GUILTY OF A FELONY AND
UPON CONVICTION THEREOF, BE PUNISHED BY A FINE NOT
MORE THAN \$10,000.00, BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT
LESS THAN TWO NOR MORE THAN TEN YEARS, OR BOTH.
