Dear Potential Darton Student,

We are very pleased you have expressed an interest in Darton College.

You should know that Darton exists to provide a better beginning for your college experience. In short, Darton specializes in the education of college freshmen and sophomores—you will never be forced to compete with upperclassmen for time and attention of faculty, for positions in campus organizations, for roles in campus productions, or for playing time on athletic teams. Moreover, because Darton is part of the University System of Georgia, you will find it easy to transfer to colleges and universities in Georgia and to other public and private colleges both nationally and internationally.

Although Darton is a two-year college, it is not a community college. In a typical year, students come from 28 states and 44 countries, making the campus a microcosm of our nation and our world. On-campus housing is available in a state-of the art residential complex where students live in single or double suites, each with a kitchen and commons area. All residents enjoy private rooms with private baths. Housing is also available in apartments near campus.

Darton ranks among the most affordable colleges and universities in the United States—costs (2009) for Georgia residents amount to \$1055 per semester; for all others, including international students, to \$3675 per semester. Georgia residents qualify for applicable Hope Scholarships and Grants. Federal financial aid is awarded to qualified US citizens and resident aliens, and academic, talent and athletic scholarships are available on a competitive basis to all students, including residents of other states and countries.

At Darton, signs of excellence abound! For example, our computer programs and opportunities for online learning have been ranked among the nation's best (in competition with senior colleges and universities); our programs in nursing and allied health are the primary source of health care professionals in Southwest Georgia, and our students enjoy high pass-rates on national certification examinations. Our NJCAA athletic program has been ranked as the top NJCAA athletic program in Georgia on two recent occasions, and our eleven (11) NJCAA athletic teams regularly complete in national tournament play.
