ASU School of Education has launched a new program called GoReact that will allow you to record yourself teaching a lesson with any device and upload it for evaluation. This allows for evaluation of your teaching without your University Supervisor having to physically visit you in your classroom. I am providing a link to some videos and guides to help you get started. **Before you can record, you will need to have the video release forms signed and returned (link to form below)**

If your University Supervisor chooses to use this platform, you will receive a link from the Goreact platform to create an account. (Be sure to check your spam folder as well).

From the link, you will need to create a student account. (directions in link below)

When you have recorded your lesson and are ready to submit for evaluation, follow the steps below and/or review the provided links below.

- 1. Once you have registered, you will be taken to your course and will click on your assigned activity.
- 2.Click on Start Assignment
- 3. Title will be assignment name and you will select your name as presenter in the drop-down box.
- 4. If your video lesson is accessible, click **Upload.** If you are doing a live recording, click **Record.**
