## Quick Tutorial Guide

ASU School of Education has launched a new program called GoReact that will allow you to record yourself teaching a lesson with any device and upload it for evaluation. This allows for evaluation of your teaching without your University Supervisor having to physically visit you in your classroom. I am providing a link to some videos and guides to help you get started. ***Before you can record, you will need to have the video release forms signed and returned (link to form below)***

**If your University Supervisor chooses to use this platform, you will receive a link from the Goreact platform to create an account. (Be sure to check your spam folder as well).**

From the link, you will need to create a student account. (directions in link below)

When you have recorded your lesson and are ready to submit for evaluation, follow the steps below and/or review the provided links below.

1. Once you have registered, you will be taken to your course and will click on your assigned activity.
2. Click on Start Assignment
3. Title will be assignment name and you will select your name as presenter in the drop-down box.
4. If your video lesson is accessible, click **Upload**. If you are doing a live recording, click **Record**.
