"PLS" DESIGNATION now available to both "SCLM" MAJORS and MINORS:

ASU graduates who complete a Major or Minor in Supply Chain and Logistics Management (SCLM) are eligible to receive a professional designation called "PLS", which stands for "Professional designation in Logistics and Supply-chain management". The "PLS" designation is awarded by the American Society of Transportation and Logistics (AST&L) and requires no additional coursework or tests beyond the requirements for a Major or Minor in SCLM. This designation allows ASU graduates the privilege to add the "PLS" designation after their name on correspondence, resume, and business cards. A MAJOR in Supply Chain and Logistics Management (SCLM) requires the completion of 27 hours in area "H": LOGM 3220, LOGM 3230, LOGM 4210, LOGM 4220, LOGM 4225, LOGM 4230, LOGM 4270, BUSA 3100, BUSA 4100.

A MINOR in Supply Chain and Logistics Management (SCLM) requires the completion of 18 additional credit hours (six classes) from area "G" (common to all Business Majors): MGMT 3106, MGMT 4199, from area "H": LOGM 3220, LOGM 4210, LOGM 4225, LOGM 4230.

College of Business Majors can complete a Minor in SCLM by taking four LOGM classes, which also qualifies for the "PLS" designation.
