Pathway: **Emergency Medical Services (0367)**

The following courses are the general education courses required for the degree in Emergency Medical Services. The student may immediately begin the EMS program Fall Semester or may begin taking courses relevant to the Associate of Science prior to applying. All general education courses required for the EMS program are also used in the completion of the A.S. degree. Please note: although BIOL 1100K is acceptable, we recommend taking BIOL 2111K & BIOL 2112K (A&P series).
