

Campus Landmark Activity Instructions

Purpose

To demonstrate students' familiarity with ASU campuses, the student will complete a map of campus of landmarks and discuss their significance.

Procedure

1. Following the Joint Session on ASU History and Traditions, ASU 1101 students should spend the next several days noting places of importance on East and West Campuses of Albany State University*.
2. Students should visit at least five areas of importance on either of ASU's main campuses*. At each area, the student should use their cell phone to take a picture of the area. Students should also create photo captions that:
 - Mention the building and/or area's name,
 - describe the area, and
 - mention the building/area's purpose.
3. Students should compile their five photos and captions into one PowerPoint slide that will be uploaded into GaView.

In addition to this activity, items related to this activity may appear on exams throughout the semester.

**Online students that may not have access to ASU's main campuses are permitted to use campus photographs available on the internet to complete the assignment.*

Grading Criteria

Student submissions will be graded using the following checklist:

35 Points	Students have included all five photographs in the slide.
35 Points	Students have included all five captions with each element described above.
20 Points	There are no distracting errors in the submission.
10 Points	Student creativity in presentation and descriptions
