MULTIMEDIA PRESENTATION AND PHILOSOPHY STATEMENT

You will be generating an educational philosophy and accompanying multimedia presentation for this assignment. The following instructions should assist you in your work

Paper Portion

For your paper, you will submit a final draft of a 1 to 2 page, double-spaced document that describes your personal educational philosophy. Your reader should be able to understand how you approach education, what you expect of your students, and how you expect to approach your work. Educational philosophies are a common document that most educators possess. In fact, many jobs will ask you for about your educational philosophy during the interview process. As such, you should be honest and reflective. Demonstrate to your readers what they might expect from you as a professional educator. A simple google search will reveal how others have written their philosophies. But, be clear, this assignment is to be your own!

Checklist for Paper

0-10 Points: Student has attached an appropriate APA-style title page.

0-20 Points: The student's philosophy is written in standardized English and avoids

distracting grammatical and mechanical errors.

0-20 Points: The student's philosophy is logically organized and easily read.

10-20 Points: The student's philosophy is at least one page and no more than three

pages in length.

10-20 The student's philosophy demonstrates reflection on the characteristics

befitting of a professional educator.

0-10 The student has used appropriate APA style citation when necessary.

Multimedia Presentation

You will summarize your educational philosophy using multimedia. You are free to use any technology **EXCEPT PowerPoint**. Many of you have mastered powerpoint and this assignment is designed to encourage you to master some other form. Previous students have used imovie, Windows Movie Maker, Prezi, Powtoons, and more to compile their project. If you visit YouTube and search for "My Educational Philosophy" you will find many examples. Be unique and ensure that multimedia presentation aligns with your written philosophy.
