Stage 1: Identify the Agency's Policy, Definitions, and Problems around the policy. Include the target population, providers, and funding streams.

Stage 2: Identify Data and Sources. What data is available to support the policy? Or, does the data support the policy? What are the desired outcomes? How are the outcomes to be measured?

Stage 3: Assessment. Use descriptive Stats. (i.e. frequencies, percentages, means based on level of measurement). Outline principles from legislative session minutes, bills, and public forums.

Stage 4: Policy options supported by data are explored and advanced.
