MOWR Program Admissions Process

MOWR students may enroll in an Associate of Art or Associate of Science core curriculum program. Applicants for this program must submit to the MOWR Coordinator in the West Campus Admissions Office, the following items:

Needed before you are accepted:

- a. A properly completed application for admission.
- b. A transcript of secondary school credits completed to date with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0 in academic subjects or a numerical average of 80.
- c. Scores meeting the following criteria:

Test	Reading (SAT) English (ACT)	Math
SAT	24	22
ACT	17	17

OR

Test	Reading	WritePlacer/English	Algebra
ACCUPLACER	63	4	MATH 1111- 79 MATH 1001- 67
COMPASS	74	60	47

Any SAT taken after March 2016 has new scoring. Old SAT scoring would be a 430 Critical Reading and 400 Math.

Haven't taken the National SAT or ACT? Take our Accuplacer exam or Institutional ACT!

Accuplacer- 1st test is **FREE**! Institutional ACT- \$60

Steps to Complete

1.	Determine your academic needs and schedule availability. Before you can decide if the program is right for you, you and your parent should determine if dual-enrollment is a good option for you. You will first need to meet with your high school counselor to determine eligibility. You can meet with Kristin Speegle to see the schedule of available courses for the semester you plan to begin, or you can also find a link to the open courses. To see courses visit asurams.edu and click students at the top left corner. Click Banner Web for Fall 2017.

MOWR Registration Process

3. Register for classes. When you have been accepted into Albany State University, you will receive a letter notifying you. You cannot register for courses until you have been accepted to the program and taken care of all holds. If this is not your FIRST semester, you will receive a letter notifying you of when to register for classes for the coming semester. You will need to complete another Student Participation Agreement (SPA) with your counselor and bring it to your registration appointment (this form must be completed each semester before registration). You can email kristin.speegle@asurams.edu or call 229-317-6942 to schedule a registration appointment. MOWR students can register early (during web registration time), so be sure to get all of your paperwork set early!

- 4. Click Schedule of Classes
- 5. Search by Term
