Set up email in the Outlook for Android app

Open the **Outlook for Android** app. The icon looks like this:



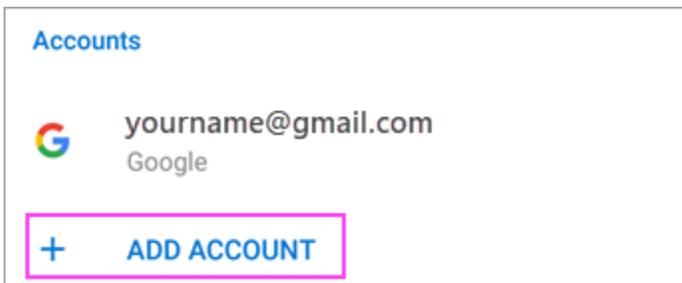
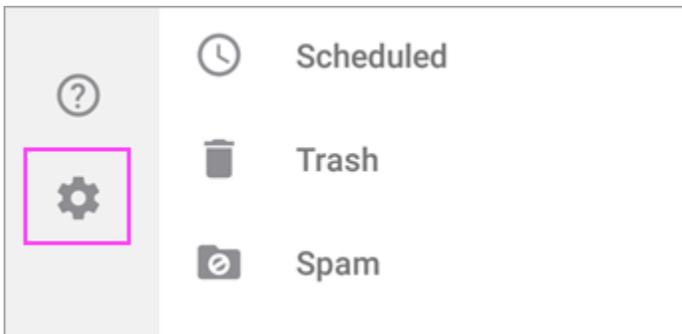
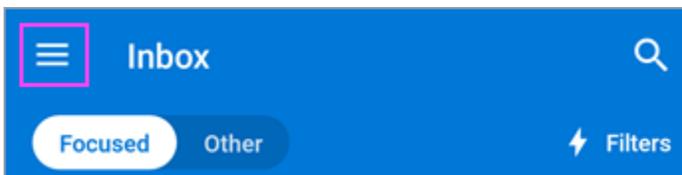
If you don't have it yet, download Outlook for Android from the Google Play Store.

Note: See www.products.office.com for more information and minimum requirements.

Tap **Get Started** if it's your first time.

Otherwise, open the **Menu** and tap **Settings > Add Account > Add Email Account**.

Enter your full email address, then tap **Continue**.

If your IT admin has set additional policies, tap **Activate** and **Activate** again. Outlook may also request permission to access your calendar, contacts, etc. Tap **Yes** or **Allow**.



Outlook Device Policy

yourname@yourdomain.com requires Outlook to be activated as a device administrator to ensure security requirements are met for your account.

Activating administrator will allow Outlook to perform the following operations:

- **Set password rules**
Control the length and the characters allowed in screen-unlock passwords.
- **Monitor screen-unlock attempts**
Monitor number of incorrect passwords entered when unlocking screen, and lock phone or erase all phone data if too many incorrect passwords are entered.
- **Lock the screen**
Control how and when the screen locks.
- **Set storage encryption**
Require that stored app data be encrypted.

Open **Outlook for iOS**. The icon looks like this:



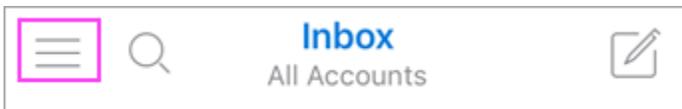

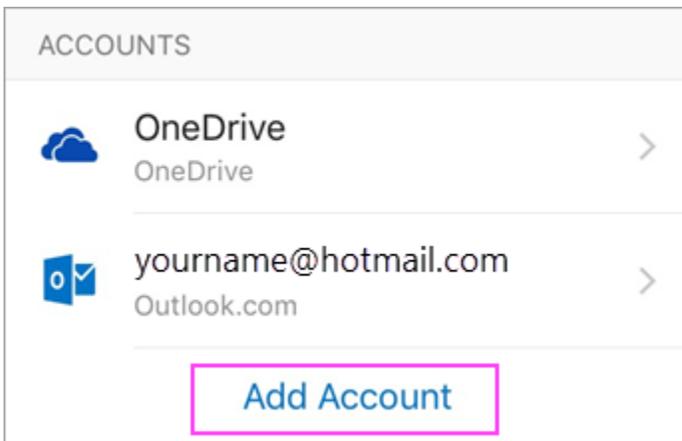

If not, tap the menu icon the upper left corner.



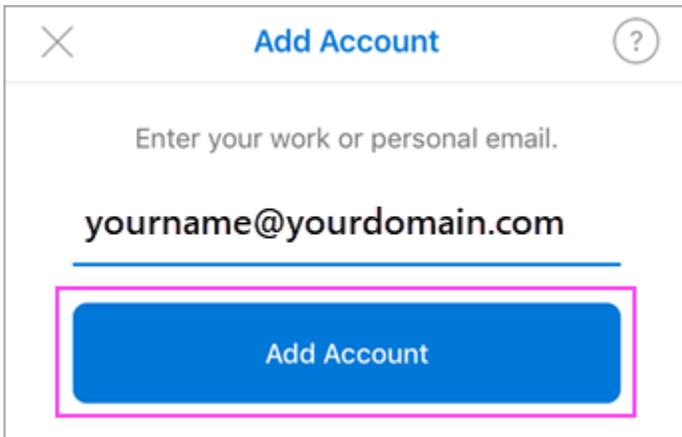
Tap **Settings**  > **Add Account** > **Add Email Account**.

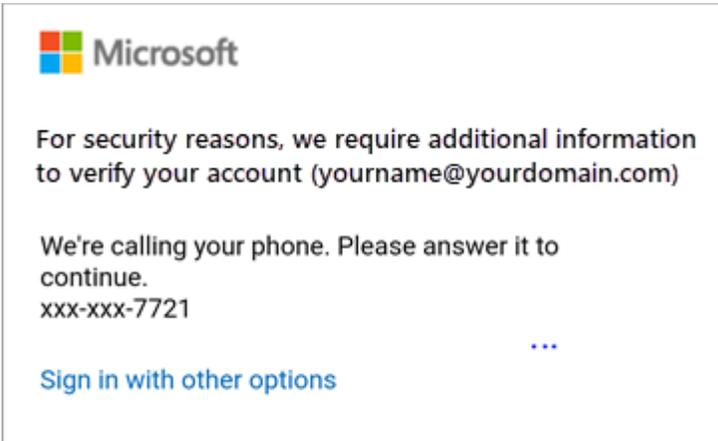

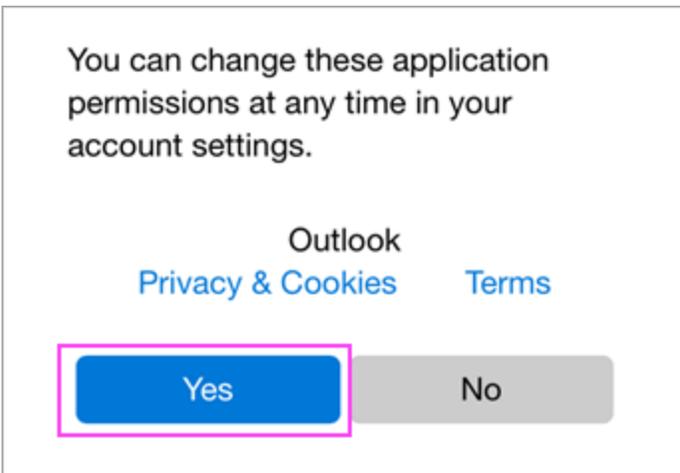
