Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, - Delta Rho Spring Chapter

This scholarship is sponsored by the Spring 1997 line of the Delta Sigma Theta, Inc. Delta Rho Chapter provides financial assistance to a student enrolled at ASU and classified as a sophomore, junior, or senior with a GPA of 3.0 or higher. Student must demonstrate a financial need and propensity toward community service.

Frederick X Terrell Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to full time student enrolled at ASU who is majoring in Criminal Justice who has a financial need. Eligible students must also have a minimum GPA of 2.5.

Albany Georgia Alumni Chapter of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity Inc., Need-Based Scholarship

The scholarship funded by generous donations from the Albany Georgia Alumni Chapter of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc. is provided to an undergraduate student enrolled at ASU whose GPA is 2.5 or higher.

Alice Coachman Scholarship

This scholarship is named in honor of ASU Alum Alice Coachman, the first African American Woman to win a Gold medal in the modern Olympics. It is awarded to a female student athlete attending ASU, with preference given to members of the ASU Women's Track and Field Team. Eligible applicants must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.75.

Annie Farmer Teacher Education Scholarship

The Annie Farmer Teacher Education Scholarship provides financial support for students who major in Teacher Education. Students must be an undergraduate registered student at ASU who has a GPA of 3.0 or higher.

ASU Army ROTC Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to a student enrolled at ASU who is an active cadet in the ASU ROTC program. Eligible cadets must be undergraduate students with a GPA of 3.25 or higher.

ASU Foundation Scholarships

Foundation Scholarships are made available to new and current students at ASU. These scholarships are awarded based on a combination of merit and need. They are made possible by the generous donations from ASU alumni, faculty, staff and friends of the University. Students who are enrolled at ASU with a GPA of 2.5 or higher are eligible for this scholarship.

ASU Gap Scholarship

These scholarships are awarded each semester based on demonstrated student need and availability of funds. Only registered students are eligible for scholarships awarded by the Foundation. Students who are enrolled at ASU and carry a GPA of 2.0 or higher are eligible for this scholarship.

Cummings Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is for an ASU student majoring in Nursing or Biology who demonstrates a financial need. Eligible students must also have a minimum GPA of 2.75.

Eddie Ray Alexander Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to a student athlete (football and women's sports) classified as a Sophomore, Junior, or Senior who is enrolled full-time at ASU. Eligible applicants must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 and an active member of the ASU Golden RAMS Football team or any female sports program.

Helen Eagle Hill Scholarship

The scholarship is given in the name of Albany Alumna Helen E. Hill and Ransom L. Hill to a deserving student based on financial need. Only registered students who are members of the ASU M.A.L.E.S. (formerly C.A.A.M) program and who also have a minimum GPA of 2.5 will be eligible to receive an award

J.C. and Annie Boatwright and Wendell & Anthony Neal Endowed Scholarship

This endowed scholarship was created to provide financial assistance to a deserving student majoring in Elementary (Early Childhood) Education at ASU. Eligible students must be classified as a Junior and also have a minimum GPA of 3.0 or higher.

The Annie and Willie Foundation Scholarship

This General and Special Scholarship is awarded to students enrolled at ASU who demonstrate financial need. In addition, students with identified physical impairments will be specifically targeted for this scholarship.

The Ben C. Hampton Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to a student who is attending ASU and enrolled in the School of Business. Only registered students are eligible for scholarships awarded by the Foundation. Students must be classified as a Junior with a minimum GPA of 3.0 or higher.

The Billy C. Black Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship, named for former ASU President Billy C. Black, is awarded to a junior or senior majoring in Chemistry, Pre-Med, or Pre-Dentistry. As with all endowed scholarships, these awards are based on availability of funds and fair market value of the endowment at the time of award

Herbert L. Murray Sr. and Ella Murray Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to an undergraduate student enrolled at ASU in memory of Herbert L. Murray Sr. and Ella Murray. Only registered students with a minimum GPA of 2.5 are eligible for this scholarship award.

The Dr. Gloria L. Hilton Nursing Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to a Nursing major who is enrolled at ASU. The scholarship is named for Dr. Gloria L. Hilton an ASU alumna and Nursing school graduate. Nursing students who are classified as a Junior, Senior, or Graduate level enrollee with a minimum GPA of 3.0 or higher are eligible to apply.

The Goizueta Endowed Scholarship

The Goizueta Endowed Scholarship at Albany State University is made possible by The Goizueta Foundation, established by Roberto C. Goizueta, the late CEO and chairman of the board of directors of The Coca-Cola Company. To be eligible for this scholarship, students must be majoring in a qualified Education degree program at ASU and demonstrate a financial need.

The Jacob and Effie Nolton Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to a full-time student at ASU who is pursuing a degree in Education. To be eligible for this award, Education majors must be classified as a Junior and maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0.

The Dr. Mollie B. Brown Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to a student who is enrolled in the ASU College of Business upon recommendation of the Dean of the College of Business. Eligible students must be classified as a Junior or Senior and also carry a minimum GPA of 2.5 or higher.

The Ransom Hill Scholarship

This scholarship will be used to support an ASU student who is an active member of the Golden Rams football team who also majors in Health and Human Performance or Education. Eligible awardees must have a minimum GPA of 2.5.

Wellington D. Swindall Book Scholarship

This award is given to help cover the costs of books and course supplies. Students must have a demonstrated financial need and possess a 3.0 GPA for High School or College.

Albany Georgia Alumni Chapter of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity Inc., Freshman Scholarship

The scholarship funded by generous donations from the Albany Georgia Alumni Chapter of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc. is provided to a Freshman from Southwest Georgia who is enrolled at ASU.

Class of 1967 Endowment

This endowed scholarship was established by the Albany State University (College) class of 1967 in order to provide need and merit based support to students matriculating at ASU. Eligible students are entering Freshmen with a GPA of 2.5 or higher.

Geraldine Hill Koonce Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to an undergraduate student enrolled at ASU who may experience emergency situations. Eligible students must have a GPA of 2.5 or higher.

James M. Barnett Memorial Scholarship Fund

This scholarship is awarded to a student who is pursuing a degree in Music. The scholarship is based in large part on talent; therefore, students must participate in an audition. Students must have a minimum 2.0 GPA.

Prince Wesley and Willie Mae Brown Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to an undergraduate student enrolled at ASU in memory of Prince Wesley and Willie Mae Brown parents of former ASU Vice President for Institutional Advancement and long-time Alumni Director Dr. Prince H. Brown and family.

The Ellen and Erma White Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is presented to an undergraduate student at ASU with preference given to a first-time Freshman. Students must carry a minimum 3.0 GPA and complete an Essay on the topic: The Role Education Plays in the Development My Personal and Career Goals.

The Marion Ross Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to a Freshman from Augusta, GA. It is named in memorial for the mother of Marion Ross Fedrick, the 10th President of ASU. Preference is given to First-time Freshmen enrolling at ASU.

The Eugene and Sara Barnett Book Scholarship

This scholarship is made possible by ASU Alumna Dr. Regina Bradley. The book scholarship is named in memory and acknowledgement of her parents Eugene and Sara Barnett. Undergraduate students enrolled at ASU who maintain a GPA of 3.0 or higher are eligible to apply.
