SOWK 4310/7139: Global Research -This course is an avenue for practical technological skills to be integrated with global issues and is designed to offer students an opportunity to explore and research subjects outside of the traditional classroom setting. The topics and issues selected should be specific to their discipline/major and the final context will include reflections and input from a UWI professor who specializes in the chosen area of research.
