COMMON QUESTIONS ABOUT EBOOKS ON EBSCOHOST

Q: Can I print out information from eBooks on EBSCOhost resources?

A: Yes, you can print up to 60 pages of an eBook or saved per user as a PDF files with the eBook full text viewer. *Note: The number of pages vary depending upon individual publishers-specified limits.*

Q: How long can I check a book out?

A: eBooks are available for up to 7 days.

Q: What if the resource I want to use is already in use?

A: If the resource is already in use and is limited to one user at a time, you will have to wait until the user checks the resource back in. If there is not a limit on the use of the resource, then you would be able to use the resource.

Q: Do I need a My EBSCO account to download and/or checkout a resource?

A: Yes, you will need a My EBSCO account to download and checkout a resource.

Q: Do I need the GALILEO password to access eBooks on EBSCOhost?

A: Yes, you will need the GALILEO password to access this database.



What is eBooks on EBSCOhost?

eBooks on EBSCOhost, formerly known as Netlibrary, is an eBook service accessible to Albany State University students, faculty, and staff through GALILEO.

What can I do with ebooks on EBSCOhost?

- Access eBooks that are a part of the Albany State University collection.
- Perform full-text searches of a single book.
- Search for information by subject, publisher, title or author.
- Access books, reference books, scholarly monographs, and much more.
- Read eBooks directly online.


How do I use eBooks on EBSCOhost?

When performing a search in the Online Public Access Catalog (OPAC), your search may sometimes return results that look like this:

The location will say "eBooks on EBSCOhost in GALILEO".



Click the title of the book you are interested in using. You can utilize eBooks on EBSCOhost by clicking on the link that says, "an electronic book accessible through GALILEO; click here".



By doing so, you will be taken to the electronic resource on the eBooks web page. Here you can read the eBook online or login to your My EBSCO account and download and check the book out.

Remember, you MUST create an account to download and checkout eBooks!

How do I create a My EBSCO account?

Click "Sign in" and "Create a New Account". You will be prompted to create a username, password and enter your e-mail address.



How do I find the book I need?

You can look for the book you need by category (ex. Education, fiction, history, psychology, etc.), or you can start by performing a basic search.



You can also search for books using the title, subject, author, publisher, or ISBN in an advanced search.



You are able to limit your results by full text, download available, publication date, subject, and category.

Select the book you would like to view and click "eBook full text" to view the book in the eBook full text viewer or click download and login to your My EBSCO account to checkout and download the book.



In the full text viewer you will have the options available to print, save, cite, select and e-mail pages from the eBook, and more.



















Be sure to utilize Boolean Operators and remember this is just like any other database in GALILEO when searching for results!
