Course Information

SOWK 7137: This is a hybrid course that will alternate with in-class and online sessions including the visiting of Jamaica to learn how agencies and/or the community respond or prevent crisis. Students will have on-site learning through visitation of crisis prevention centers in Jamaica. They will have a cultural lecture from faculty at University of West Indies, Jamaica Campus, and visit several sites and landmarks.

SOWK 6032: This course is primarily a face to face course with a hybrid portion that gives students the opportunity to visit Jamaica during Spring Break. Students will engage their learning towards family practice in Jamaica by on-site visits to family service agencies. Students will visit historical sites and interact with students and faculties at the University of West Indies (UWI), and they will also have presentations with lecturers in the Social Work department at UWI.
