

Albany State University and Albany Technical College **Transfer Articulation Agreement** March 2020



Introduction

This agreement formally recognizes that Albany State University (ASU) and Albany Technical College (ATC) are active educational partners in providing educational opportunities for currently enrolled and potential students of both institutions. Agreement to this partnership requires a commitment by both institutions to serve and facilitate a student's ability to transfer into a degree program without jeopardizing the intended mission and stated goals of either institution.

Agreement on Accreditation

Both parties agree to maintain regional accreditation through the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC). Should either institution lose accreditation through SACSCOC, the other institution may terminate the agreement through formal written notice.

Agreement on Communication

Albany State University and Albany Technical College agree to cooperate in communicating with each other concerning the articulation relationship between the two institutions. Communications may include common publications and announcements concerning their affiliation. Announcements of this articulation and of changes in the relationship will have a coordinated release to the public from both institutions. The institutions will encourage the dissemination of information about programs in this agreement to interested and qualified students, with both institutions providing advising and counseling to prospective students.

Agreement on Articulated Courses

This agreement is specifically for students completing the courses included in this document at Albany Technical College who are transferring to complete a baccalaureate degree at Albany State University. This agreement does not apply to other institutions in the University System of Georgia. Any Albany Technical College student who completes the courses detailed herein at ATC, is in good standing at ATC, and meets the appropriate admission requirements to attend Albany State University will be ensured that the courses listed in this agreement earned at Albany Technical College will transfer to Albany State University. A minimum grade of "C" or above will be required for ENGL 1101, ENGL 1102, and any other courses designated by specific majors in accordance with their program requirements.

No student may transfer more than 75% of the credit required for an associate or baccalaureate degree. Both institutions are committed to advising students accordingly so that credit earned is applied appropriately to the degree. Students who plan to change from a non-science major to a science major may need to take additional courses in Areas A-E. This agreement replaces any former agreement.

Agreement on Maintenance and Review

Albany Technical College

At least one administrator or faculty member will be appointed from each participating college/university to act as a primary point of contact and agent for this agreement, to speak for the institution, and to communicate details and modifications to respective faculty, advisors, and others with interest at the individual institutions.

This agreement will be in effect for three years from the date of administrative endorsement. Review of course content changes will be completed annually. It will be automatically renewed unless one of the parties expresses, in writing, its desire to terminate the agreement, giving six months' notification with the effective date to be the last day of the following academic term.

Transfer Articulation Agreement
March 2020

Albany State University's **Nursing RN to BSN** Completion Program and Albany Technical College's Associate Degree Nursing Program

Introduction

This agreement formally recognizes that Albany State University (ASU) and Albany Technical College (ATC) are active educational partners in providing educational opportunities for currently enrolled and potential students of both institutions. Agreement to this partnership requires a commitment by both institutions to serve and facilitate a student's ability to transfer into a degree program without jeopardizing the intended mission and stated goals of either institution. ASU and ATC are committed to expanding educational opportunities for Registered Nurses.

Agreement on Accreditation

Both parties agree to maintain regional accreditation through the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on colleges (SACSCOC). Should either institution lose accreditation through SACSCOC, the other institution may terminate the agreement through formal written notice.

Mutual Terms and Conditions

Both educational institutions will cooperate toward developing, disseminating and presenting the articulated program information to students.

Graduates of the Albany Technical College Associate Degree in Nursing program who have completed the associate degree with a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.80 or better, have achieved the RN license from the NCSBN, and have met the admission requirements of Albany State University, will be accepted into the Nursing RN to BSN Completion Program at Albany State University's Department of Nursing. Those with a GPA of less than 2.80 and who also meet the admission requirements of Albany State University, will be considered for admission on a space available basis.

Students transferring from Albany Technical College may transfer credit hours toward their baccalaureate degree. Students must complete a minimum of 30 credit hours at Albany State University at the 3000 and 4000 level to be eligible for a Bachelor of Science with a major in Nursing.

Students are subject to the policies and procedures of both institutions.

Students intending to transfer should complete the admissions process for Albany State University by the appropriate deadlines of their final semester of their associate degree program.

A Curriculum Equivalency Guide will be used by Albany State University and Albany Technical College to identify courses that will effectively transfer and prepare Albany Technical College students for success in the Albany State University program.

Albany State University and Albany Technical College will enter into a Financial Aid Consortium by complying with the necessary information sharing, to entitle students in these programs to the appropriate federal, state, and institutional assistance. This process includes annual reporting of tuition fees and academic calendar dates.

Both parties will comply with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) and all associated regulations, taking the necessary steps to ensure that confidential personal information is not disclosed or distributed.

All parties agree to continue their respective policies of nondiscrimination based on Title IV of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 in regard to sex, age, race, color, creed and national origin, and other applicable laws as well as the provision of the American Disabilities

Act.

The term of this agreement is for 3 years from the date of execution and shall automatically renew for successive one year periods unless a party gives notice of non-renewal 12 months in advance of the expiration of the applicable term.

Both institutions, Albany State University and Albany Technical College, may at any time initiate changes to this articulation agreement. Both institutions reserve the right to modify programs as deemed necessary and agree to inform the appropriate individuals of said changes.

Agreement on Maintenance and Review

Albany Technical College

At least one administrator or faculty member will be appointed from each participating college/university to act as a primary point of contact and agent for this agreement, to speak for the institution, and to communicate details and modifications to respective faculty, advisors, and others with interest at the individual institutions.

This agreement will be in effect for three years from the date of administrative endorsement. Review of course content changes will be completed annually. It will be automatically renewed unless one of the parties expresses, in writing, its desire to terminate the agreement, giving six months' notification with the effective date to be the last day of the following academic term.
