Facts of BINGE drinking

Binge drinking is defined as a pattern of drinking that brings a person's blood alcohol concentration (BAC) to 0.08% or above. This usually happens when men consume 5 or more drinks and women consume 4 or more drinks within 2 hours.

According to national surveys:

- Approximately 92% of U.S. adults who drink excessively report binge drinking in the past 30 days.
- 70% of binge drinking episodes involve adults over the age of 25.
- About 90% of the alcohol consumed by youth under the age of 21 in the U.S. is in the form of binge drinking.
- Abut 75% of the alcohol consumed by adults in the U.S. is in for form of binge drinks.
- The proportion of drinkers that binge is the highest in the 18-20 year old group (51%).
