LOG ON HELP FOR ONLINE MATH CENTER

The Math Center provides support for any math class on campus, from the earliest remedial class up through calculus. The highly skilled staff consists of a director, two assistant directors, and several student workers.

The Math Center is open for students who want to "drop-in" for homework help and/or need clarification on a mathematical topic. No appointments are necessary. The center is also open to online math students who may find it difficult to grasp a topic and need assistance. Support is provided in a number of ways. Students can receive one-on-one tutoring from any staff member. In addition to individualized assistance, different technologies are available. Students have the choice of working on a computer with different software packages or they can watch videos (either from the Internet or on DVD).
