3. Completion of the required pre-requisite and general education courses with a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher. In addition students must earn a grade of "C" or better in the following courses: ALHE 1120, BIOL 1100K, CHEM 1151, PHSC 1011K, and BIOL 2115.

 - 2.2.1 Varicella X 2 (or proof of immunity)
 - 2.2.2 HBV X 3 (or proof of immunity)
 - 2.3 Acknowledgement Forms
 - 2.3.1 Accreditation Acknowledgement
 - 2.3.2 Health Insurance Form
 - 2.4 Physical Evaluation Form
 - 2.4.1 Curriculum Plan
 - 2.4.2 Letters of recommendation (optional; 3 max)
- 3 Academic requirements: minimum GPA of 2.5 and completion of published prerequisite courses.
- 4 Online students must have a Letter of Support from a current clinical affiliate of the Program or a hospital willing to affiliate with the program that can meet the training needs of our students.
