Admission Criteria

To be considered for admission to the Diagnostic Medical Sonography (DMS) program, the applicant must

 1. Be admitted by Albany State University (ASU).

 Please do not send the ASU application or fee to the MSP Program. The two application processes are separate and no additional feel is required when submitting the DMS Program application.

 2. Submit the completed DMS application by the Julie 1" deed deadline

The student must complete and submit a Diagnostic Medical Sonography application by the June 1st deadline for fall admission to the Health Sciences office, located in J-210. It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure all application material has been completed by utilizing the checklist at the end of the application.

- Must include an Observational Hours Form verifying a minimum of 30 observational hours in a Diagnostic Medical Sociography setting (located in application packet).
 Must include capital exists on Recommendation Form (located in application packet).
 Must include copies of all transcripts from previous colleges/unversities or technical schools.
 Must exist the Applicant meets the following minimum regimemants.

- Must complete a minimum of 30 observational hours of experience in one or more Diagnostic Medical Sonography settings. This excludes 30:40 ultrasound facilities.
 The hours must be documented and verified/signed by a Sonographe.
 An Observational Hours Form is located within the application packet.

Pre-requisite courses must be completed prior to the start of the program with a grade of "C" or better.

SELECTION PROCESS

After the June 11 desdiller, the DMS selection Committee reviews and scores each application. Applications will be processed and all applicants will be contacted via email no later than June 15. The top 20 applicants will be sent an invitation via email for a personal interview. Sowing is based on the following criteria: prerequisite course completion, cumulative DPA, the number of Husus observed in one or more disposal; emided is enougraphy settings, previous health care experience or a degree/certificate in an allied health field, the personal interview, and appropriate recommendations received. After completion of interviews, the applicants will be selected. Correspondence of acceptance or reget will be made through email and should be received no later than July 12. Selected students must confirm their intent to erroll in writing (via e-mail) within 10 days of their acceptance e-mail. A student that falls no respond in the appropriate time will forfest their position. The DMS program does not utilize a waiting list and those deried acceptance must reapply the following year.
