Following consolidation, it was determined that the students that were previously enrolled in Darton were not required to take the EDUC trio course that prepares students for the GACE content test. Subsequently, these students may cause a decrease in student completions for the next three years. Plan for improvement these completion rates include framing the entrance essay to reflect content knowledge that would have been gained in the EDUC trio (EDUC 2110, 2120, 2130).
